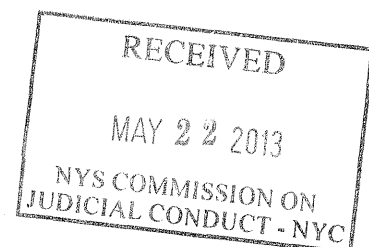
Please be advised that I represent Judge George. Regarding your letter dated May 02, 2013, citing Judiciary Law Section 44(8), please find enclosed this original letter, six copies and proof of service on the Commission on Judicial Conduct.

Judge George is making an application to the Chief Judge of the Court of Appeals, the Honorable Jonathan Lippman, for a review pursuant to Judiciary Law Section 44(7).

Judge George's reason why he should not be suspended while a review is pending are as follows:

FIRST: The relatively short period of time the review process takes. It is expected to be completed between three and four months.

SECOND: Mr. Linder's letter dated May 10, 2013, which takes no position on the suspension.




