Commission Re-Elects Chair and Vice Chair to New Terms

The New York State Commission on Judicial Conduct re-elected Thomas A. Klonick as Chair and Stephen R. Coffey as Vice Chair at its meeting of April 15, 2010. Commission officers serve two-year terms and are eligible for re-election. Both Judge Klonick and Mr. Coffey were first elected to their respective positions in 2008.

Judge Klonick serves as a part-time Justice of the Town of Perinton (Monroe County) and has his own law firm in Fairport (Monroe County). He has also served as an Acting Rochester City Court Judge, a Fairport Village Court Justice and as a Hearing Examiner for the City of Rochester. He was appointed to the Commission in 2005 by former Chief Judge Judith S. Kaye and re-appointed

by Chief Judge Jonathan Lippman in 2009. He served as the Commission's Vice Chair from June 2006 to March 2008.

Mr. Coffey is a partner in the law firm of O'Connell & Aronowitz in Albany. He was appointed to the Commission in 1995 by former Senate President Pro Tem Joseph L. Bruno, and re-appointed in 1999, 2003 and 2007.
