Attorney Graham B. Seiter **Appointed to Judicial Conduct Commission**

Graham B. Seiter, an attorney whose office is in Oswego County, New York, has been appointed to the New York State Commission on Judicial Conduct by Assembly Minority Leader William A. Barclay, for a four-year term ending March 31, 2025.

Mr. Seiter is a graduate of Saint Lawrence University and Syracuse University College of Law. His law practice includes family law, criminal defense, real estate, estate planning and business formation. He has also served as the Town Attorney to the Town of Richland, New York, since 2019.

Mr. Seiter began his career with the law firm Caraccioli & Associates, PLLC. He is currently the president of the Oswego County Bar Association.

Mr. Seiter succeeds Paul B. Harding, Esq., whose had served on the Commission since 2006 and as Vice Chair of the Commission from 2016 to 2020.

Background on the Commission

The Commission was established in 1978 by the New York State Constitution to review complaints of misconduct and disability against judges and justices of the State Unified Court System and, where appropriate, to discipline publicly those judges found to have engaged in misconduct.

The Commission is composed of 11 members, all of whom serve without pay. The Governor appoints four members (two of whom must be non-lawyers/non-judges), the Chief Judge of the State of New York appoints three members (all of whom must be judges) and the four leaders of the State Legislature appoint one each.

The Commission has a full-time staff operating from offices in New York City, Albany and Rochester.
