The determination of the Commission, its findings of fact, its conclusions of law, and the record of the proceedings upon which the determination is based were transmitted on April 14, 2022 to the Chief Judge of the Court of Appeals in accordance with Judiciary Law § 44(7);

The service and notice requirements of Judiciary Law § 44(7) were complied with on April 14, 2022;

Proof was obtained that Hon. Carlos Gonzalez received on April 18, 2022, the determination of the Commission, findings of fact, conclusions of law and record of the proceedings upon which the determination is based; and no request for review having been made; NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with Judiciary Law § 44(7), it is

ORDERED that the determined sanction is accepted, without costs, and Hon. Carlos Gonzalez is removed from the office of Justice of the Elmsford Village Court, Westchester County. Judges Garcia, Wilson, Singas, Cannataro and Troutman concur. Chief Judge DiFiore and Judge Rivera took no part.
