## MEMORANDUM

March 17, 2022

TO: Full-Time Judges and Justices of the Unified Court System  
FROM: Lawrence K. Marks *LM*  
RE: Reporting of compensation for extra-judicial activities

This is a reminder that section 100.4(H)(2) of the Rules of Judicial Conduct requires that full-time judges report the date, place and nature of any extra-judicial activity for which the judge received compensation in excess of \$150, and the name of the payor and the amount of the compensation received. These reports must be made at least annually and filed as a public document in the office of the clerk of the court in which the judge serves. If a judge received no compensation within the meaning of this rule, no report need be filed.

We recognize that the disclosure requirement of section 100.4(H)(2) is in large part duplicative of the Financial Disclosure Statement that judges must file every year with the Unified Court System's Ethics Commission, and we are evaluating whether this process should be simplified and streamlined. In the meantime, however, the disclosure requirement of section 100.4(H)(2) remains in effect.

**(2) Public Reports. A full-time judge shall report the date, place and nature of any activity for which the judge received compensation in excess of \$150, and the name of the payor and the amount of compensation so received. Compensation or income of a spouse attributed to the judge by operation of a community property law is not extra-judicial compensation to the judge. The judge's report shall be made at least annually and shall be filed as a public document in the office of the clerk of the court on which the judge serves or other office designated by law.**

Hi judges – Andrew sends a reminder to file this report around every year. The income would usually be attributable to teaching, which some of you do, or for new to the bench judges, income due from practice that has been wrapped up but money still owed – not sure our musicians make more than \$150.00 per year although they are all excellent musicians. The clerk of the court on which you serve would be your Chief Clerk's office/deputy chief/ and unfortunately in those courts that have neither at the moment call me and ask if you have compensation for this year. In the event you forgot to do this in the prior five (5) years, you might want to "nunc pro tunc" a filing. To say that we are under public scrutiny at the moment would be an understatement. This should be a simple letter stating the facts requested.
